I managed keeping my speed and finished first in 49:37 on the 8km course in the woman 14′ class.

On Sunday we had the sprint races where I decided to compete in both, the 12'6" and the 14', woman classes. Comfortable I made my way into the semi-finals, where I had a good beach start on my 12'6" x 24" Javelin LE and managed a start-to-finish qualifying for the final. After a short break it took me a lot of energy to save my entry into this final. Only ten minutes rest until the final of the 12 '6" class where I finished 3rd with a short margin on the 2nd. So in another short break I put all my energy together for another exhausting final where I didn't gave up my lead after an exploring beach start.
